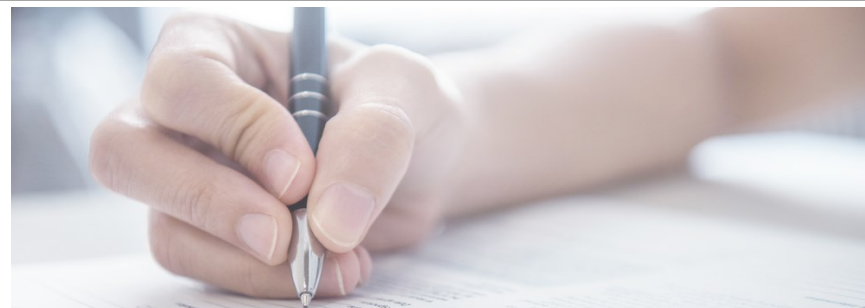

PLAYING TRIVIA

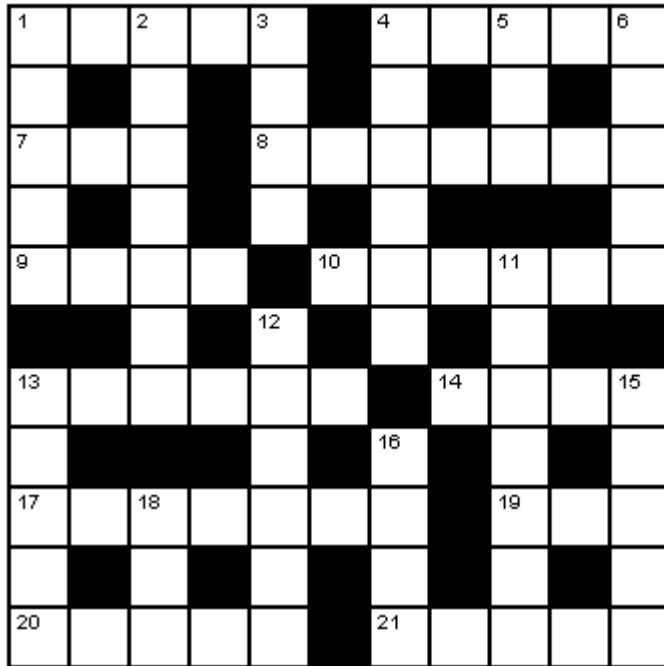
Trivia is a great way to test your memory for general knowledge and history. Simply write your answers underneath each question. Great to do with friends or on your own.
